6	<b>Time Trial Secretary's Report</b> Sue mentioned that the monies collected at the time trials does not always match the number of entries. It was not thought to be an issue.	Closed

	There were 21 entries for the 5, 10 for the 9 and 27 at the Try for Free. The TT due to be run on the 12 May was cancelled due to adverse weather conditions. This was communicated via the website, Facebook and Twitter.	Closed
7	<b>Road Race Secretary's Report</b> At the John Andrews Road Race two accredited marshals did not turn up on the day, although they had not confirmed they would be in attendance. The dynamic risk assessment highlights anything not already found in the initial risk assessment. This will include allocating additional marshals at various points. The club is still awaiting the new risk assessment incorporating risks highlighted in the dynamic risk assessment. Due to another event taking place adjacent to HQ, car parking is likely to be an issue at the Ham Hill/Pittards race. It was suggested to either move the HQ to Yeovilton or hold only one race in order to reduce entrant numbers, It was agreed to move the event HQ to Yeovilton if possible. Nick James to cancel Long Sutton as HQ if new HQ is determined. If approval is not received to move HQ, one race will need to be cancelled. It was agreed that this would be the Pittards race. Those entered in the cancelled race will be offered a place in the remaining race. Nick Armstrong allocated roles for committee members at the HH/Pittards race plus additional roles for other club members, The John Andrews race made £300, catering costs and expenses still outstanding.
