This is not the first time he has been seen to instigate an altercation with a motorist, although the first time on a club run. As Ben is not a club member Martin explained that he would not be welcomed on club runs nor would an application to join be accepted.

As the cooler weather approaches the Thursday rides will go into winter mode with shorter outings and the long ride options on Sundays will be dropped.
